It's still hard for me to think that the summer is over.

As you'll see in our newsletter, we've had a packed several months, hosting seven interns from across Canada. We've been training, teaching and equipping them almost non-stop this summer - it's hard to believe it's over!

But it's been well worth it. Minds have been changed, hearts have been moved and lives have been saved because these young men and women decided to dedicate their summer to help make abortion unthinkable.

For example, last month, many of these interns attended Calgary First Church of the Nazarene when I gave the Sunday morning sermon.



Not only did they get a chance to see me speak before a large service on a Sunday morning, they were able to engage many of the people in the congregation after the service. Usually, I only speak to a fraction of the people at my talks but with their help, we were able to speak to almost anyone who had questions about how they could help make abortion unthinkable.

The internship has been an especially encouraging time for those of us who've been doing pro-life work for a while. When I hear these young people using the tools and arguments we teach them to save lives, like Francisco did

(see inset in the CCBR newsletter), I can't help but be proud.

Now that the students are back at their schools, they aren't stopping pro-life work. They all have committed to take what they've learned and to do our projects back at their universities.

But just because the students are gone, that doesn't mean the work stops. CCBR presentations will occur this fall all over Canada and the world, and our local projects (including our truck project) constantly run in Calgary.

And we're already planning for a new batch of students to join us in Florida next February for a Genocide Awareness Project tour, along with another team of interns in 2011.
